

Explanation of How to Accumulate Points

Please refer to the FOB Board page for open positions.

FOB Board President: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible to oversee the entire program, along with organizing and running monthly meetings and other meetings as necessary. Also a member of the Executive Board which handles any issues that can't be handled in the normal monthly meetings. This is a position elected by the Board. Exempt from having to earn points.

FOB Board VP: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible to oversee the entire program, along with handling any of the duties of the president when the president is unable to. Also a member of the Executive Board which handles any issues that can't be handled in the normal monthly meetings. Also will assist in organizing and running the FOB tournament. This is a position elected by the Board. Exempt from having to earn points.

FOB Board Secretary: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible to record and distribute minutes from any meetings of the General or Executive Boards. Also a member of the Executive Board which handles any issues that can't be handled in the normal monthly meetings. Also will help assist in organizing and running the FOB tournament. This is a position elected by the Board. Exempt from having to earn points.

FOB Board Treasurer: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible to collect and record all income and pay and record all debits, to help create a budget and to provide an annual actual vs. budget report. Also a member of the Executive Board which handles any issues that can't be handled in the normal monthly meetings. This is a position elected by the Board. Exempt from having to earn points.

Concession Director: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible for overseeing all aspects of the concession stands including: cleaning and maintenance, menu and pricing, ordering, purchasing, and preparing all food, drinks, and supplies. Exempt from having to earn points.

Mickelson Concession Coordinator: Coordinate with the concession director to run the concession stand at Mickelson Middle School. Exempt from having to earn points.

Little League Concession Coordinator: Coordinate with the concession director to run the concession stand at the Little League fields. 50 pts.

Points Director: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible to record points earned by each family, to post them and to help report or correct any problems or issues. Exempt from having to earn points.

Little League Director: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible for organizing teams and team coordinators, scheduling games, communicating with team coordinators through out the season. Exempt from having to earn points.

Registration/VFW/Legion Director: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible for scheduling and running registration for all levels, organizing team coordinators for the VFW & Legion levels and communicating with the team coordinators through out the season. 40 points.

Equipment Director: Voting member of the FOB Board. Responsible for ensuring we have adequate and safe equipment for all levels, putting a list together of equipment needs, organizing a system so we know who has the equipment and ensuring the equipment is returned. 30 points.

Uniform Director: Responsible for issuing uniforms to the teams at the Bombers, Bullets, Bandits and little league levels (assist the Little League Director), ensuring the uniforms are returned and are not abused. Monitor the condition of uniforms. 20 points.

Media Relations Director: Responsible for maintaining and updating the Brookings Baseball website, organizing a system for reporting scores, upcoming meetings, events, etc to the local media. 30 points.

Ad Book Director: Responsible to organize, sell advertising, set up printing and distribute the ad book on an annual basis. Exempt from having to earn points.

Ad Book Sales: Contact businesses to buy advertising space in the book, points to be determined based on number of contacts made.

Bingo Director: Responsible to schedule workers for our bingo fundraiser at the VFW. Exempt from having to earn points.

Fundraising Director: Responsible to schedule, organize & run fundraisers other than bingo & ad book. 40 points.

Game Scheduling Director: Responsible for scheduling the games for the VFW level teams. Exempt from having to earn points.

FOB Tournament Director: Responsible for organizing & running the FOB tournament, will be assisted by the vice-president and secretary. 40 points.

Tournament Director: Responsible to organize and run any state tournament we host and the Wayne Hauschild Memorial Legion tournament. 30 points.

Umpiring Director: Responsible for scheduling umpires for VFW and Legion level games, including any tournaments that may be hosted at those levels unless they are assigned by the state, and scheduling the umpires for our FOB tournament. 40 points.

Insurance Director: Responsible for ensuring all our teams, board, board members players, coaches are covered with adequate insurance. 20 pts.

Money Bag Director: Responsible to ensure that the money bags used at the concession stands and gates are collected and distributed properly. Can schedule families to be responsible, similar to the concessions. 40 points.

Money Bag Coordinator: A family responsible for the money bags for a week. 10 pts/week.

Concessions & Gate Scheduler: Schedule families to work at the different concession stands and gates. 30 pts.

Season & Tournament Pass Coordinator: Responsible for printing and distributing season and tournament passes. 20 pts.

Raffle Ticket Coordinator: Responsible for printing and distributing any raffles we have. Also responsible to collect proceeds from the raffles. 20 pts.

Team Coordinator: Responsible to help the organization of a specific team. Some responsibilities are to communicate with the other parents and coaches, organize travel, along with other duties as necessary. 30 pts.

Junior Bandit Coordinator: Responsible to organize and run the Junior Bandit program which is where a little league team goes out on the field with the Bandit team. 20 pts.

Hy-Vee Receipt Coordinator: Responsible to promote, collect and total Hy-Vee receipts collected for FOB. 20 pts.

City Relations Coordinator: Responsible to communicate with the City of Brookings as necessary relating to facility issues, licenses, tournament refunds and other items as necessary. 20 pts.

Mailing Coordinator: Responsible to organize any mailings necessary, whether for tournaments, to alumni, registrations etc. 20 pts.

Little League Head Coach: Responsible to help run and organize a little league team. 40 pts. (positions tbd)

Little League Ass't Coach: Responsible to help run and organize a little league team. 20 pts. (positions tbd)

Work at a concession stand: Work a shift at any of the concession stands as scheduled. This shift requires two family members to be present. 10 pts/shift/family.

Work at the gate: Work a shift at any of the gates as scheduled. 10 pts/shift.

P.A.: Run the P.A. at Bob Sheldon. 10 pts/double header.

Scoreboard: Run the scoreboard at Mickelson or Bob Sheldon. 10 pts/double header.

Tournaments: Work a shift at any tournament we host throughout the summer, especially the FOB tournament. 10 pts/shift.

Board Meetings: Attend a monthly FOB Board meeting. 5 pts/family.

Bingo: Play bingo any Monday night throughout the year (this costs you money to play). 5 pts per paid player. (If three people in a family attend and buy one package of cards they earn 5 pts, if three people in a family attend and buy three packages of cards they earn 15 pts.). Each person will earn 5 points for each night you work at bingo.

Split Pot: Run a split pot at a Cubs, Legion, VFW or Little League game/night. 5 pts.

Assist a director: Help a director with their tasks, amount of points dependent upon amount of time spent etc., to be determined by points coordinator and/or the Board.

Miscellaneous: Families will be able to earn points through out the year by helping or running different things. For example, we had a pancake feed recently, the families who volunteered their time to help will receive 10 pts. These points will be at the discretion of the points coordinator and/or the Board.

Points required to be earned by families

Little league: 50 pts

Bombers: 60 pts

Bullets: 60 pts

Bandits: 70 pts

High School: 20 pts (add to summer total if kid plays both)

Maximum points required by one family regardless of number of kids = 140 pts

Points can be accumulated from Jan. 1st each year until Dec. 31st that same year to reach your total. Parents will write a check for \$5.00 per point they are required to earn through the year, that check will be dated for Dec. 31st of the year, if they don't earn their points through out the year their check will be cashed.
